EMERGENCY LOCKDOWN RESPONSE CODES

CODE RED: LOCKDOWN

Lock doors, cover windows, close blinds, students stay in the location they are currently located.

CODE BLUE: CLEAR HALLS

Students stay in classrooms

CODE YELLOW:

FIRST AID REQUIRED

Students stay in classroom

CODE BLACK:

ADULT ASSISTANCE REQUIRED

Students stay in classroom

NOTES

Emergency Lockdown drills must be completed 6 (3) times per year. Administration is to review each drill and report effectiveness through a PA announcement. A staff debrief will occur as necessary unless otherwise specifically requested.

PA Script:

May I have your attention please. We are now in a code ___RBYB__. A code ___RBYB__ is now in effect. Clear the halls. Close and secure classroom doors. Listen for further instructions. Code ___RBYB__ is now in effect.

Descriptions:

Code Red: Lockdown: Lock doors, cover windows, close blinds. No one leaves the classroom while code red is in effect. No one is to leave the classroom for any reason. Students out of the classroom when a code red is called are expected to remain in the location that they are until the code is lifted.

Code Blue: Clear Halls: Close classroom doors. No one leaves the classroom while code blue is in effect. Students out of the classroom when a code blue is called are expected to return to their classroom as quickly as possible.

Code Yellow: First Aid Required: Close classroom doors. No one leaves the classroom while code yellow is in effect. Students out of the classroom when a code yellow is called are expected to return to their classroom as quickly as possible.

Code Black: Adult Assistance Required: Close classroom doors. No one leaves the classroom while code blue is in effect. Students out of the classroom when a code blue is called are expected to return to their classroom as quickly as possible.

Bathroom breaks for codes blue, yellow and black:

Is a password needed for code red? How do we know that it's okay to open the door if there is a knock?
